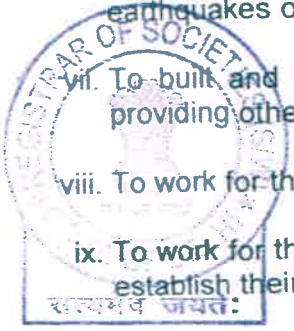

Aims & objectives of the society

The aims & objectives of the SOCIETY are/ shall be:-

- i. To construct orphanage meant for the orphans, abandoned children, rescued child labor, and deprived children. To help these children built their homes and earn good livings as per Govt. rules.
- ii. To establish formal and informal educational centers including adult education centers for poor children and other communities as per Govt. rules.
- iii. To establish / manager/ arrange the Hospitals and Clinics for deprived community as well as for General public as per Govt. rules.
- iv. To make for the eradication of superstition and social evil such as dowry, child marriage etc.
- v. To start activities for peace of mind by promoting yoga, preaching other such activities that seen necessary for over all development including religious activities.
- vi. To provide relief for the persons who fall to pray to natural calamities such as cyclones, earthquakes or other such calamities.
- vii. To built and run old age homes for the old age persons of deprived community and for providing other such assistance etc. to old age people.
- viii. To work for the AIDS/HIV victims and other health related issues so as to make society sage.
- ix. To work for the prostitution to bring them back in the main streams of social life and help they establish their own respectable business and life.
- x. To establish, maintain, operate, administer & run institution, school, college, and libraries for the spreading and permeation of knowledge and education in general in the nature of academic, technical, professional, vocational, physical, medical etc. as per Govt. rules.



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- xi. To publish books, newspapers, journals or other kind of study and promotional material and to run library, reading room for weaker section of society.
- xii. To organize and conduct dramatic performance and cinematography and other work of art.
- xiii. To help the development of intellectual, moral, economic social condition of the people in general and SC/ST, OBC, Minorities and other weaker section of the society.
- xiv. To open start and manage technical education and prepare the boys and girls.
- xv. To work sincerely for the mankind and humanity in Delhi & City disciplines without any discrimination of colour cast creed religion, reign, country or any such limitation.
- xvi. To establish, maintain, open and found the orphanage asylums, shelter homes for all age group.
- xvii. To accept gifts, purchase, exchange, lease or bequests, devises or donation of any moveable or immovable property or any rights or interest therein members on others.
- xviii. To make efforts for the solution of general problems for the aforesaid block's residents with the help of the concerned government authorities and solve them especially such roads, telephones, medical and charitable dispensaries, schools, college, play groups, libraries reading rooms and community control etc. rural and urban areas.
- xix. To found, assist & maintain and run, establish the centers for the destitute for their city development and to work with all NCT Organizations related children.
- xx. And to do all necessary acts, deeds and things for the betterment of women children & people.
- xxi. To protect the human rights for general public at all levels.
- xxii. To eradicate the social evils, to help the abandon, lonely, handicapped, dumb deaf, disable people.
- xxiii. To borrow, land and otherwise deal with the monies properties belonging to the society and to give security to take in connection with the said dealings or acts in the name of society.
- xxiv. To collect subscription, grant in aid, funds or other charity from persons bodies, charitable societies, trust, firms, and Govt. and borrow money or raise loan on interest or otherwise and deposit money in such manner as may be deemed fit and utilize the same for the furtherance of the aims and objects mentioned above and acquired land and property in manner for the benefit of the society.



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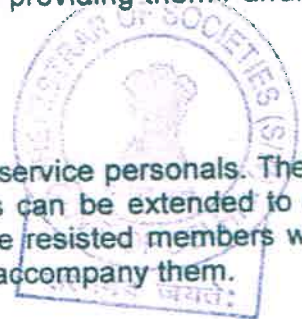
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- xxv. To provide for the deliver of spiritual discourses by eminent scholars from time to time, to provide a forum for exchange of thoughts on social, cultural, educational aspects & to celebrate festivals with special occasions.
- xxvi. To launch and promote the health programs for all age groups.
- xxvii. To work for the up-liftmen of the handicapped/s, blinds, physically disabled of all age groups, to provide proper treatment and all helps.
- xxviii. And to do all necessary acts, deeds and things for the betterment of humanity and mankind. To seek affiliation with societies, institution, bodies. Schools, college or universities for furtherance of any objects as may be deemed necessary in India & abroad.
- xxix. To take steep and efforts for he protection of environment and atmosphere and educate people how to maintain and preserve polluted free environment.
- xxx. To provide resettlement to ex- serviceman (ex army personals) by providing them / arranging for them jobs after retirement.
- xxxi. To provide security services to other organizations/ corporate.

However, this shall not prevent payment in good faith of remuneration to any employee of the society or other person in return for services rendered.













**Rules & Regulations of Society Named As
Dignity Restoration and Grievance Settlement Association (DRGSA)**

1. MEMBERSHIP:

The membership of the society is open to any person or persons who has attained the age of majority and fulfills the terms and conditions of the society without discrimination of the religion, case, colour or creed but subject to the approval of the governing body. If the membership is refused to certain person or persons of refusal shall be communicated to the person concerned.

2. SUBSCRIPTION:

Admission fee Rs.1100/- at the time of member and subscription Rs.100/- per annum.

3. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

- a) The Governing Body shall have the power to excel a member from the society on the following terms and conditions:
- b) By no confidence motion passed by 2/3rd majority of votes.
 - c) On his/her written termination.
 - d) He/her not attended three consecutive meetings of the general body without any intimation.
 - e) President, Gen. Treasurer, will be the life time member.
 - f) On his/her death.
 - g) That the present will be life time member in the society have no election in same post.

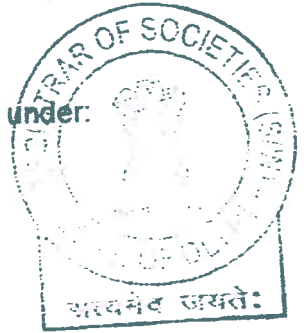
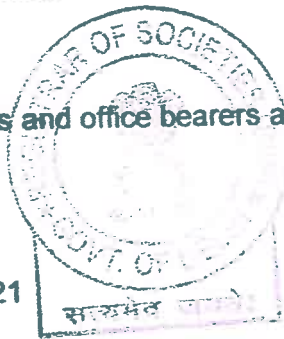
The reason of the termination from the membership shall be communicated to the member concerned.

Appeal: All the appeals should be referred to the general body of the society. The decision of the General Body shall be final. The reason for rejection shall be communicated to the member concerned.

4. GOVERNING BODY STRENGTH:




The governing body shall consist of members and office bearers as under:

5. BANK ACCOUNT:

The bank of account of the society shall be operated by the President and Treasurer or Secretary.

6. GENERAL BODY:

All the members of society will constitute the general body.

7. FUNCTION OF THE GENERAL BODY:

- a) To consider any work activities brought forward for the following for the governing body.
- b) There shall be an annual meeting of the general body in the month of March every year.
- c) Not less than 15 days notices shall be given to the members before the day of general body meeting enclosing the agenda specifying date, time and place and the quorum shall be 2/3rd.

8. GOVERNING BODY:

The governing body's strength shall not be less than two and not more than twenty one. The member of the governing body shall hold the office for five years. The emergency meeting of the governing body shall be held as and when necessary, for which 15 days clear notice will be required and the quorum shall be 2/3rd.

9. ELECTION & QUORUM:

The general body will elect its president and all the office bearers and members after five years by secret ballot papers and 3/5th members in every next election will be taken from the original governing body.

10. FUNCTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY:

To arrange finance if required from various sources:
Institution or individuals on reasonable terms and condition and the governing body....

- a) The governing body shall make plan for the future program of the society.
- b) To publish literature and to propagate the system to approach the public pertaining to up liftments of status of the society.
- c) Governing body shall meet at least once in three months.
- d) To accept donation, charities, loan, grants, properties etc., from public, other associations agencies, Government departments in the interest of promotion of aims and objectives of the society.

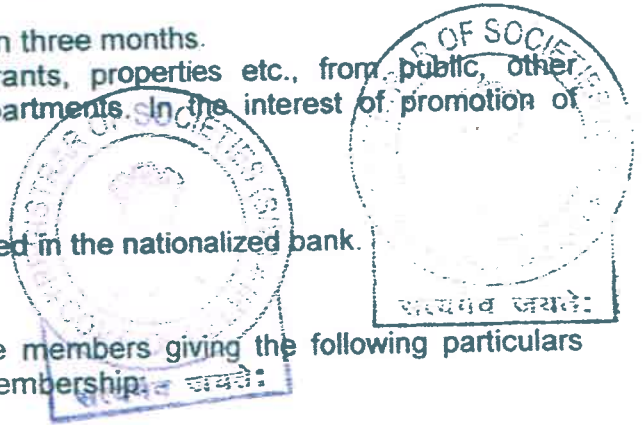
11. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS:

All the income of the society shall be deposited in the nationalized bank.

11.A REGISTER OF MEMEBERS:

The society shall maintain a register of the members giving the following particulars regarding entrance or cessation of his/her membership:

- a) Name & address of the member.
- b) The date of which a member ceased to be such member.
- c) The date of cessation/ termination of members from the society.
- d) The date of birth of the member.
- e) Occupation of the member.
- f) Date of governing body meeting by which the decision regarding the membership was taken.

11.B RIGHT AND PRIVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS ALL AND EVERY MEMBER OF THE SOCIETY:

- a) Shall have one voice at every meeting.
- b) Shall be entitled to participate in the meeting & religious cultural functions and other lawful gathering called/ arranged by the society.
- c) Shall be bound by the rules and regulations and/ or bye-law which may be framed from time to time.
- d) Shall make his/ her activities to promote/ develop the aims and objects of the society. Every member is also supposed to administer the oath of office and loyalties to the society and/ or its constitution to the president.
- e) To elect governing body of the above society.
- f) To attend the governing body meetings.
- g) To give the necessary information to the society pertaining to any matter which is necessary to be known by the society.

11. FILLING OF CASUAL VACANCIES:

The casual vacancies may be filled by the resolution passed by majority of votes by both the governing body and general body.

12. POWER AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS PRESIDENT:

He/ her will be the head of the society and preside over the meeting of the general body and governing body. He/ she will have the right if casting the vote incase of tie. He/ she will be the signing authority for all official documents and corresponding letters. All important decision shall be taken and finalized by the approval of the president. His/ her job will also include the following:

- a) To a minister control of all the administrative and official activities of the society.
- b) To keep control of staff and assign them duties and fix up accountability, punish, promote and terminate the services.

VICE PRESIDENT:

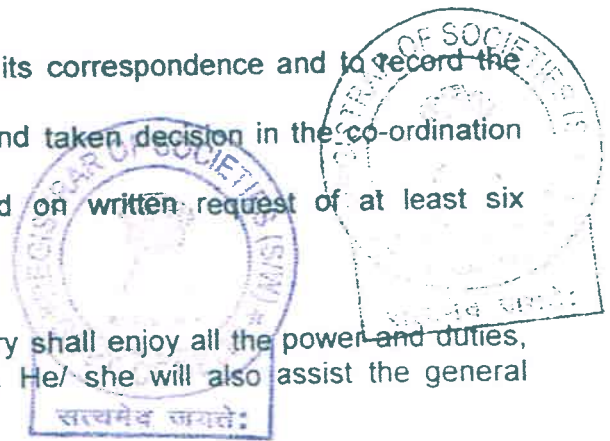
In the absence of president the vice president shall enjoy all the powers and duties that are associated to the president. He/ she will also assist the president in his work.

- a) To sign on behalf of the society to conduct its correspondence and to record the proceeding of meetings.

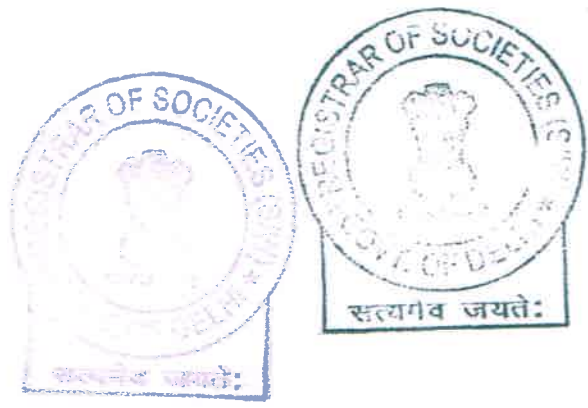
